G rard Lamarche was appointed Executive Vice President of GDF SUEZ in charge of Finance in July 2008, after the merger of GDF and SUEZ.

In 1983 he began career in Deloitte Haskins & Sells, Belgium, and in 1987 he became consultant in mergers and acquisitions, in the Netherlands.

In 1998, Lamarche joined Soci t  G n rale de Belgique, as management controller, and held this position from 1989 to 1991. He was consultant for strategic operations from 1992 to 1995. In 1995 he joined Compagnie Financiere de Suez, as special assistant to the Chairman and Secretary of the Management Committee (1995-1997). Later, he participated in the merger between Compagnie de Suez and Lyonnaise des Eaux, which became Suez Lyonnaise des Eaux in 1997. Then he held the position of Managing Director in charge of Planning, Control and Accounting, and Secretary of the Investments Committee (1997-2000).

G rard Lamarche continued his career in the industrial sector and in 2000 joined NALCO (American subsidiary of the group and leader in industrial water treatment) as Chief Financial Officer. In February 2003, he was appointed Executive Vice President of SUEZ, in charge of Finance, responsible for financial operations, cash, taxation, planning accounting and control. In March 2004, G rard Lamarche was appointed Senior Executive Vice President of SUEZ, responsible for financial operations.
